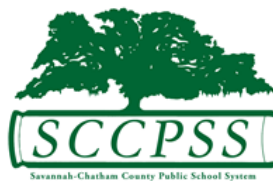

Godley Station K8 Green Ribbon Highlights

Godley Station has worked to improve use of renewable energy while reducing energy costs. A greenhouse, water saving receptacles and a solar panel have been installed and have been operational since August 2016. This solar panel has produced 425,500 kwh as of December 29, 2017.

The school's garden club uses the green house and green areas of the school to produce vegetables as part of the district's Farm to Table initiative, and the cafeteria uses the yield to supplement their salad bar. School outdoor activities include Sweet Feet Soccer, Girls on the Run, Garden Club and six athletic teams to include softball, soccer, volleyball, basketball, baseball and football.

The program inspires children to reduce, reuse, recycle, turn off lights, conserve water, and realize how their actions affect the environment. The Green Ribbon objectives are to save money by eliminating waste, conserve natural resources and incorporate sustainability into the curriculum.
